Ageing in oak barrels exclusively, for 14 months (20% new barrels)

The locality of Saint-Désiré, by its geographical location, combines the talents of Beaune with some accents of Pommard.

Indeed, we find in each vintage a solar and fleshy wine, always greedy and silky, typical of the good plots of this vast appellation.

The neighbour Pommard still has an important influence and brings a serious matter

It is a wine that can be tasted surprisingly young, the tannins are never strict, and keeps the aging capacity of a decade for perfect maturity.

Will accompany any red meat.
